SPRING 2018 CLASSES January 2018 – June 2018

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE

BIB 101 – Introduction to Old Testament: 3 Semester Hours

The course is designed to familiarize the student with the content of the books, which comprise the Old Testament. Instruction will also focus on the ancient history of the Israelites as a nation and chosen people. Critical analysis and various methodologies will be employed in exploring the works that make up the Old Testament volumes.

BIB 102 – Introduction to New Testament: 3 Semester Hours

This course is an introduction to the content of the New Testament canon with focus on perspectives and methods of historical critical investigation and interpretation.

BIB 103 – The Pentateuch: 3 Semester Hours

A systematic approach to the study of the first five books of the Old Testament, touching on the early history of mankind but dealing more specifically with the beginning period of the Israelites and stressing the typological significance of the patriarchs in Genesis, the tabernacle in Exodus and the ceremonial offerings in Leviticus.

BIB 104 – The Gospels: 3 Semester Hours

This course is a systematic approach to the study of the four Gospels, treating them as a four-fold picture of our Lord, and harmonizing the apparent discrepancies into a composite whole. Attention is given also to some special topics such as the parables and miracles, and some critical questions are examined.

BIB 105 – Pauline Epistles: 3 Semester Hours

This course is a systematic approach to the study of the letters of the Apostle Paul, giving due consideration to their historical setting, their major themes, and the spiritual and practical implications of their message for today.

BIB 106 Pauline Epistles II: 3 Semester Hours

Continuation of Pauline Epistles I – **Prerequisite Pauline Epistles I**

BIB 203 – Analysis (Acts): 3 Semester Hours

This course is an analytical approach to the study of this important historical book, which is the link between the Gospel and the Epistles. Emphasis is placed upon the inauguration and expansion of the early Church, the functions of the Holy Spirit, and the ministry journeys of Paul.

EVA 101 – Evangelism: 3 Semester Hours

This course provides the students with an understanding of the basic principles of evangelism, analysis of appropriate materials and methods while offering the opportunity to engage in preparation for outreach

PAS 204 Leadership: 3 Semester Hours


A course that will examine leadership styles and facilitate the development of skills in leadership, organization and management as they relate to specific ministry needs and situations.

OTS 501 – Survey of Old Testament: 3 Semester Hours


The focus of this course is learning the context of all the books of the Old Testament. Students will take regular quizzes on the contents of the books. Students will also be introduced to the history of ancient Israel and some of the critical methods employed in studying the text.

HIS 502 – Church History I: 3 Semester Hours

This program is designed for people who desire to understand their calling within a more complete theological perspective so that they may serve more effectively as Christians in the world. The MRE also will help individuals prepare themselves for professional ministry and those pursuing leadership in various educational ministries of the church and para-church organizations.

PPC 504 – Spiritual Formation: 3 Semester Hours

This is an introductory course designed to assist first year students in identifying and understanding their spiritual formation and development. The course includes discussion and theological reflection as it relates to course objectives. Particular attention is given to how students understand theological education, call to ministry, spiritual, personal, and professional identity formation. Students will have the opportunity to dialogue with local pastors/spiritual leaders.
